



Retired Rehire Information

We currently have several vacant police officer positions within the Louisville Metro Police Department. To fill these positions with high quality experienced candidates, we are seeking retired police officers from the Louisville Metro Police Department. To help aid in your decision regarding applying, we have listed some facts below:

- The annual pay will be the same level of service the retiree had with LMPD when they retired. So, if you retired with 20 years of service their base pay will be at the 20-year rate which is \$78,062.40 plus the \$4,300 for KLEFPF pay for a total of **\$82,362.40**. ([click here](#))
- Retiree will accrue vacation time at the same level of service they had with LMPD when they retired.
 - Vacation Accrual per Contract:

Years of Service	Bi-weekly Leave Earned
1 – 4 years	6.55
5 – 9 years	8.39
10 – 14 years	9.31
15 – 19 years	10.24
20 – 24 years	11.16
25 – 29 years	12.09
30 years and over	13.02

- Retiree may be eligible for Metro Health Insurance.
- Retiree may work an off-duty job after they complete the required initial training.
- Retiree will be eligible for a take home car after they complete the required initial training.
- Retiree will not be contributing into CERS nor will they get a second pension.
- Retiree will have assignment preference of patrol division, but the Chief of Police has the ultimate discretion based on needs.
